

Order of Services

Sunday Morning Treat like a guest speaker with no changes to your regular service. A Member of *Power For Life* Strength Team will only preach a message, give an invitation to accept the challenge given, and take up a love offering. We will not be doing any feats of strength in that morning's message. The length of message will be between 25-40 minutes depending on your time that your church has allotted.

All Night Services Service will open with 2 fast paced congregational songs. After music, a representative from the church will welcome everyone and talk about one of the ministries @ the church. If your church does a give away, this is when this give away should take place. This should take only 20 minutes and then it will be turned over to *Power For Life* Strength Team. We will do feats, take up an offering, and give an evangelistic message. The total service time will be 1 ½ hours. After the invitation is given, those that came forward will be escorted to another room for more counseling. We will turn the service back over to the church @ this time.

The team will go into the counseling room and make a statement and turn it over to the counseling team. This will give instant credibility to those on the counseling team. The *Power For Life* Strength Team will then go and sign autographs for all of those who desire one and afterwards the team will eat dinner.

School Assembly The *Power For Life* Strength Team will need to be there 20-30 minutes prior to the start of the assembly. There isn't much to set up. The team will need a wireless microphone (preferred) and a sound system to play their CD during feats. The team is introduced to the students by either a school representative or the person from the church. The *Power For Life* Strength Team will speak for 30-50 minutes depending on time allotted by the school and will mention where the night time program is going to be and invite everyone a minimum of 3 times. We will ask that you try to get up to 4 assemblies a day maximum.

Leadership Teams that are needed from the church

- Promotional** The responsibility of this team to make sure the word is out to the community. "**Untold is Unknown**" Avenues such as newspapers, poster teams, door to door invites, radio, and etc. are crucial to making this a successful event. Your target audience is "Everyone that can make it inside". Don't promote this just as a youth event, this is an event for ALL ages, races, & genders. Let people know that there will be some of the strongest men in the world coming to your church.
- Materials** This should be a group of members that will get all of the materials for the event, both crusade and school assemblies. This teams' goal is to have ALL of the materials in hand 1-2 weeks prior to the crusade. It is very important to no procrastinate because the longer you wait the harder it will be to find certain items.
- Counselors** The responsibilities of the counselors are to take those that came forward into a different room to have them fill out a response card (created by your church). When a person has made a decision to accept Christ, it is the counselor's job to make sure that they understand the decision that was made. Having each person fill out a card gives you the information needed for follow up.
- Follow Up** Follow up needs to be done within 24-48 hours. When an individual makes a commitment to Christ and leaves the confines of the church, the devil will attack. This team's goal is to make sure that the individual knows that your church cares about them and would like for them to join their fellowship. This teams' job isn't to recruit members from other churches, they are to give them choices of churches in their area that will mold them into being a better Christian. Contact other churches to let them know if they need to follow up with that individual. The ultimate job is to build the Kingdom not the local church.

Ushers

The responsibilities of the ushers are to pass out our envelopes that we provide to every person in the church. Your team will be called back to receive the offering. Please put the offering in a secure area and give to Team Leader or road manager. Our team will count the offering and give you a total the next day. If your church has any questions about this please call us.

Prayer

This team should consist of any Christian member of the church that has a desire to see lives changed. We want everything that you do for this event bathed in prayer from posters, materials, seats, and etc. We ask if you would dedicate one Sunday prior to our arrival to prayer for the crusade, safety of team members, lost souls to be saved, all of those in leadership of this event, church growth, and etc. This team's mission should be that God is welcomed and that He has free reign over every service.
