<input type="checkbox"/>	170	Cinder blocks – 16" X 8" blocks (reusable and returnable) Home Depot or Wal-Mart (returnable)
<input type="checkbox"/>	300	Scalloped lawn edgers (5 or 6 humps on one side, straight on the other, 24 inches long). Try not to purchase the 16 inch bricks. Home Depot or landscaping business.
<input type="checkbox"/>	30	Cap blocks – 8" deep x 4" thick, 1ft- 1½ ft high – Hint: half the thickness of a cinder block (reusable and returnable) Home Depot or Wal-Mart
<input type="checkbox"/>	300	Wood spacers – ¾" x ¾" x 4" long (Hint: 1" x 4" x 10 ft. works well for this. Ten foot strips can be easily cut into ¾" pieces.) Please have these cut before arrival. Home Depot/ Lowe's-
<input type="checkbox"/>	12	New wooden baseball bats – 34" length (Louisville Slugger recommended) Call Leitchfield Bat Co. @ 1-800-635-3098 or 270-259-5510 ask for Jerry or Mark. The cost is \$10 per bat. Please order two weeks prior to crusade. "Add 1 bat for every school"
<input type="checkbox"/>	6	Hot Water Bottles – Call the office to place your order. \$9 per bottle (including shipping) orders must be placed 10 business days before your crusade.
	3	3 pairs of goggles to protect eyes from water bottle. –Wal-Mart
<input type="checkbox"/>	10	Large telephone books (2' or 3' thick only) Call a big city phone company. "Add one extra for every school"
<input type="checkbox"/>	5	Aluminum Frying pans – Chef Mate or Regal Brand, 12" diameter at Target or Wal-Mart \$12 each.
<input type="checkbox"/>	5	License plates from a local junk yard/salvage yard.
<input type="checkbox"/>	3	12 packs of Diet 7-UP or Diet Sprite in cans (Wal-Mart)
<input type="checkbox"/>	14	Steel bars – HOT ROLL (charcoal or gray in appearance; 1/2" diameter by 5' long; not shiny, not rebar) call local welding shop (helpful Hint found @ the bottom of this page) "Add one extra for every school"
<input type="checkbox"/>	4	Steel bars – HOT ROLL (charcoal or gray in appearance; 3/4" diameter by 5' long; not shiny, not rebar) call local welding shop (helpful Hint found @ the bottom of this page)
<input type="checkbox"/>	5	Dozen medium size hand towels (1 1/2' or 2' in length) Wal-Mart (this item is used on top of brick breaks)
<input type="checkbox"/>	5	Rolls of Duct Tape Home Depot or Wal-Mart
<input type="checkbox"/>		1/2" or 3/4" thick particle or wafer boards, get enough to cover entire stage area, edges taped together with duct tape (Stage should be decked out after Sunday AM Service) Home Depot –
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	1" x 12" x 10' white pine boards cut into 9" pieces (make 24-26 pieces) Home Depot
<input type="checkbox"/>	5	2" x 4" x16' DRY WHITE PINE Premium Boards Home Depot
<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Telephone Pole – 10-12 ft. long, 12" – 15" diameter, 300 to 350lbs (difficult for an average adult to wrap their arms around) Can be located by calling local telephone or Energy Company. DO NOT CUT
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Steel Gate Handles Wal-Mart-

<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Chain Saws to Prepare log (must have very sharp chain and one back up chain) Home Depot or Wal-Mart or borrow from a member of church
<input type="checkbox"/>	12	1½ inch screws for steel gate handles for log Home Depot or Wal-Mart
<input type="checkbox"/>	60	Bottles of drinking water Wal-Mart
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Wheel barrels to remove waste- only with bricks borrow church members
<input type="checkbox"/>	10-12	Stage crew needed for setup, tear down, and trash removal – 10-12 men needed 1 ½ hours before and 1 hour after.
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	5 Gallon Buckets Wal-Mart or borrow them from church member
<input type="checkbox"/>	4	10 lbs CO2 Fire Extinguisher call local fire dept for information on where to get this item
<input type="checkbox"/>	5-6	Pairs of gardener cloth gloves (rubber dots) - Wal-Mart
<input type="checkbox"/>	3	Cans Coleman Fuel in gallon tin cans Wal-Mart
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Fire axes (regular, full-length 8 lb. each) These axes have a pick ax on one side and a regular ax on the other side of the handle. Ask local fire department if you can borrow they are not damaged in any way or purchase at Home Depot. Keep receipt and return. We do not damage axes.
<input type="checkbox"/>	10	Sharpie markers for autographs Wal-Mart
<input type="checkbox"/>	100	Black ink pens for information cards for follow-up
		Helpful hint for steel bars: Get on the internet and Google steel companies in your zip code. When the list comes up please call and get the best price. Ask them to be a sponsor and give the steel to you @ cost or as a donation. Make sure that it is HOT ROLLED steel.
